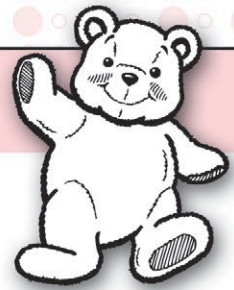

Clap your hands while saying each of the Bible Words. Invite your child to join in clapping and saying the words.

For shirts and pants, (*touch each*)
sock and shoes, (*touch each*)
for clothes, God,
we thank You! (*fold hands*)

Folding Laundry

Let your child help with laundry. Show your child how to fold a pair of socks together or fold a shirt. While you fold clothes together, say, "I'm glad God gives us clothes to wear. Our clothes keep us warm and dry."

When it's time to dress your child, let your child choose between two outfits. After your child makes a choice, help her get dressed. As you name the different pieces of clothing your child is wearing, ask her to point to them. Remind your child that God gives us clothes.
