TOGETHER TIME!

Have a Tell About Jesus day! Encourage everyone in the family to tell about Jesus in as many ways and places as possible that day. Encourage sending e-mails, making phone calls, or sharing with friends and co-workers. Have a family meeting at the end of the day to discuss how and where everyone told about Jesus. Write down all of the ways and places and count them up. Pray that each family member will continue to tell about Jesus.



GAME TIME!

Play an alphabet I Can Tell About Jesus game. Sit in a circle. Ask each person to name a place where he or she can tell about Jesus. The place must start with the first letter of the person's first name. For example, Hannah could tell about Jesus in a house. See how many times you can go around the circle naming different places to tell about Jesus. You might want to try places that begin with the first letter of middle names too.



LOOK IN THE BOOK

Read together this week's Bible story from Acts 27:1–28:2, 7–10.
