Bible Words

"God made everything"
(based on Acts 17:24).

Pat the Bible as you say the
Bible Words. Invite your child
to pat the Bible and
say the words too.

(point to the sky)

I can reach and touch it too.

(reach toward the sky)

God made the sky for me to see.

(point to eyes)

I'm as happy as I can be.

(smile and clap hands)

Take an old blanket outside and lie on it with your child. Talk about the beauty of God's sky. Pick a cloud and tell your child what you think it looks like. Also look for birds and planes. Remember to thank God for making the sky.
