01 Lesson Materials

In this folder you will find materials to enhance your teaching. Consult your printed *Leader Guide*, which will show you how and when to use all of these resources.

- *Leader Guide* Lesson Outlines

Customizable outlines are provided to help you plan and organize your supplies and thoughts for each lesson.

- PowerPoint Files

We've supplied you with presentation slides for your teaching time, including blank slides in this quarter's color scheme, unit title slides, and lesson title slides. You'll also find a slide for each Remember verse that goes with each lesson, to help your students learn Scripture together. PDFs of all slides are also provided for use with other programs, as needed.

- Tools

Use these resource articles to learn more about your audience or to help train volunteers.

- Your View Student Conversation Cards

Students may use the View pages of their printed *Student Guides* to lead part of the lesson's Bible study and discussion in small groups. If you don't have enough printed guides (or even if you do), just print out these one-page conversation cards to give student leaders an easy way to facilitate discussion.

02 Videos

In this section you'll see all the video resources for the quarter, including three unit videos and one lesson video per lesson (all offered as MP4 files). The unit videos provide a summary of the main concepts being conveyed in each unit. They can also be used for training purposes or to communicate unit themes to parents.

If you need to send any of these resources to other teachers or volunteers, you can put them onto a flash drive or use a cloud-based service (like [Dropbox.com](https://www.dropbox.com)) and send them a link to it via email. If your congregation has Internet access, then working directly from the cloud-based service will work. If your congregation does not have Internet access, then download the resources onto your computer, tablet, or mobile device.

Using the Visual Files

If your computer or device is less than a decade old, chances are it already has software that can play MP4 files and open image files. The easiest way to find out is to double-click the file you want to view. If it plays or pops up, you're set. If not, Windows users can download a video player such as [Windows Media Player](https://www.microsoft.com/windows/windows-media-player/). Apple products already come with the appropriate software loaded.
