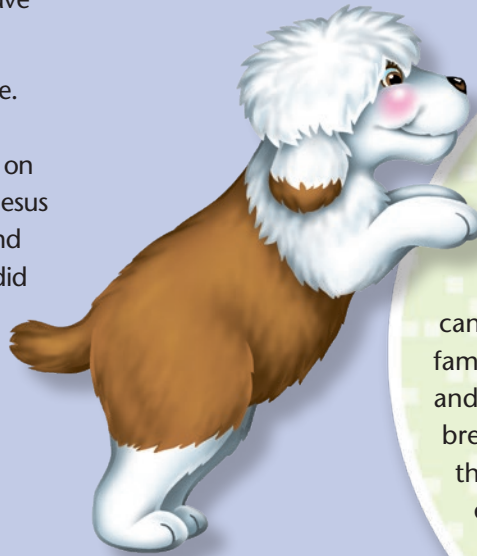
## Bible Memory FUN
