**Main Scripture:** 2 Corinthians 5:16-21; Galatians 4:1-7; 1 Peter 2:9; 1 John 3:1, 2

### 5 THINGS TO KNOW FROM THIS LESSON

- This week, we're beginning a new unit about identity. This lesson focuses on who we are in God.
- We talk in this lesson about what identity is and what things make up a person's identity.
- Being certain or confident about who you are and where you come from can help you to grow into the person God made you to be.
- Scripture message: If we are uncertain about who we are, we can go to Scripture and find out who God is and who He says we are in Him. We are chosen, known, seen, and loved by God.
- The Bible tells us that when we believe in Jesus, repent of our sins, and accept Him as our Savior through baptism, we become God's children. God's chosen us, and He loves us deeply. Nothing can separate us from His love. In Him, we're made new, and all our mistakes, failures, weaknesses, and flaws are forgiven. This is our truest identity.
