Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Genesis 1:1; John 1:1-3.
In the beginning was the Word. Who was the Word and what did He do?
- **MONDAY**—Read Psalm 104:24, 25.
How do these verses praise God?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Psalm 104:19-23.
Could all the things mentioned in these verses happen by accident the way some people want us to believe?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Psalm 104:5, 6.
Let each family member tell God what he or she thinks is God's most incredible creation.
- **THURSDAY**— Read Psalm 8:3-5.
How do you feel knowing that you are such a special part of God's creation?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Psalm 100.
As a family, tell God what an awesome world He made.
- **SATURDAY**—Read Psalm 33:6-8.
How can we worship God every day and thank Him for all He has given us?
