## Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Genesis 2:7, 18-22.  
Who brought together the first family?
- **MONDAY**—Read Ephesians 6:1-3.  
What is the first commandment with a promise?
- **TUESDAY**—Read 1 John 3:11, 12, 17, 18; 4:21.  
How does God want us to treat each other in our family?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Genesis 25:29-34; 27:36, 37.  
Jacob tricked his brother Esau two times. Have you ever tricked a brother, sister, or friend? Did you ask for forgiveness?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Genesis 27:41-45.  
What happened to Jacob and Esau after the second trick?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Genesis 32:3-12; 33:1-4.  
How did Esau respond to Jacob's message? Could you forgive someone who has tricked you?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Romans 12:9, 10, 16-18, 20, 21.  
How should we treat others at all times?
