Family Devos (A Guide for Family Devotions)

Gather in a family room or around the kitchen table. Open a Bible. Read the verses listed. Answer the questions; respond to the statements. Listen to and share with one another. Grow in God's Word—together!

Set a goal for your family. Will you have devotions together one or two days a week? Can you work up to seven days?

- **SUNDAY**—Read Acts 23:12-22.
Has there ever been a time when you found it difficult to talk about Jesus? What was the situation? What did you do?
- **MONDAY**—Read Proverbs 14:25.
How are we saving lives when we tell people about Jesus?
- **TUESDAY**—Read Matthew 28:19, 20.
When we hear good news, we don't keep it a secret. Who can we tell about Jesus today?
- **WEDNESDAY**—Read Acts 1:7, 8.
The apostles told people all over the world about Jesus. Where can we tell about Jesus?
- **THURSDAY**—Read Acts 8:26-39.
Philip told a man from another country about Jesus. Who do we need to tell about Jesus?
- **FRIDAY**—Read Matthew 9:35-38.
Missionaries tell about Jesus throughout the world. Who are some missionaries we can pray for?
- **SATURDAY**—Read Matthew 5:14-16.
We don't have to be missionaries to let people know about Jesus. How can we live our lives so people will see Jesus living in us?
