Most of what young children learn about their world

is not actually taught, but is caught, through all five senses. This week your child learned how Daniel obeyed God through the sense of taste.

Provide a variety of food choices for your child. Encourage your child to describe what something tastes like and to savor the different tastes God has given us. Think about ways to make the most of your child's other senses too.

God knew what He was doing when He gave us eyes, ears, noses, mouths, and hands. Use these gifts as one more means of teaching your child the importance of obeying our wise and loving God.

Bible Read-Along. Sit together with a Bible. Find and read the Bible story from Daniel 1:1-16, 19. Talk about the Bible story. Take turns asking one another questions about the Bible story. Share how we learn to obey God like Daniel and his friend's obeyed God. Pray that God will help members of your family to obey Him.
